- Utilize consultative sales techniques to convert leads to clients
- Respond to inquiries via email and provide detailed trip information
- Speak with thousands of prospective families over the phone and communicate the excitement and transformative nature of our trips.
- You will only call warm leads (no cold calling) and qualify them based on their level of interest.
- Position requires calling thousands of people and you will face rejection (as well as excitement) everyday.
- Though most of the time you will be selling, occasionally you'll also be asked to assist with program support and customer service.
- Support the on-call system while clients are traveling
- Through this position you will be given the ability to develop skills and knowledge that will accelerate career advancement and future professional opportunities.

Minimum Requirements

You have sales experience: at least 2 years of phone-based sales or customer service experience. Ideally, you have done consultative sales before.

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- 2 years experience with phone-based sales or customer service
- You are flexible and have a sense of humor
- Passionate about the transformative nature of travel
- Highly motivated and proactive
