BRAZIL: RIO CARNIVAL FESTIVAL

Often called Cidade Maravilhosa (The Marvelous City) Rio de Janeiro is unmatched in its breathtaking landscapes and location, nestled between lush, green mountains and crystal-clear seas. And there is no better time to visit Rio than during Carnival, considered to be the largest in the world. With Discover Corps, you'll go behind-the-scenes as an invited guest of a local Samba school to actually join in on the parade! Venture to local neighborhoods to experience blocos, or block parties, tour the Grande Rio Samba School and learn how to dance samba.

Over the course of seven days, we'll also explore all that Rio de Janeiro has to offer. Cruise high in a cable car to Pão de Açúcar (Sugarloaf Mountain), venture to Christo Redentor (Christ the Redeemer statue), and relax on the iconic beaches of Copacabana and Ipanema. We'll also dive into Brazilian culture with a private Brazilian cooking class & percussion workshop. Our boutique hotel located on the famous Copacabana Beach will put us in the center of all of the action.

CUBA: HAVANA JAZZ FESTIVAL

Cuba is synonymous with jazz and this is never more evident than during the country's famous Jazz Festival as the music dominates Havana. The beauty of the five day event lies in the fact that the music is everywhere – creating the sense of one continuous song – as the notes blend together near seamlessly while you meander through the city.

Explore Hemingway's former home, Finca Vigía, the colorful art installations of Fusterlandia and visit Havana's famous Museum of Fine Arts. You will also experience the talent of the Habana Compas dance troupe, meet the children of the music center Muraleando, and explore Old Havana - a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Beyond Havana and its surrounding neighborhoods, spend one day in the gorgeous Viñales Valley. Perhaps Cuba's most picturesque spot, explore tobacco farms and meet with farmers to learn about their life and work.

A place of mysticism & wonder, Morocco is known for its picturesque mountain views and unique blend of ancient and modern cities. And the most colorful time to visit Morocco is during the World Festival of Sacred Music in Fès. A multi-day event of music, workshops and renowned artists from across the globe, this is arguably the most anticipated festival in the region.

Over the course of ten days, we'll tour old-world Fès (the largest car-less city in the world!), the beautifully blue-hued Chefchaouen, and the bustling Marrakech, making brief stops in Morocco's capital, Rabat, and the world-famous Casablanca. OAXACA: DAY OF THE DEAD FESTIVAL

Oaxaca is the heart of traditional Mexican culture and there is no better time to be in this UNESCO World Heritage designated city than during the iconic Day of the Dead festivities. The region comes to life as colorful parades line the colonial streets and families convene to celebrate their loved ones. As a Discover Corps guest, you're in for an experience. We'll show you a side of Oaxaca that only locals see while engaging in all of the festivities that this holiday brings.

Over the course of six days, we'll combine visits to all of the must-see sites including the archeological ruins of Monte Alban with cultural experiences involving local weavers, potters, distillers and, of course, those bringing the emerging Oaxacan cuisine onto the map. We'll also join local families to take part in their Day of the Dead ceremonies while immersing ourselves in the heart of the city's most impressive parades & performances.
