OUR PURPOSE

The epicenter of traditional culture, the Kingdom of Thailand is known for its lush greenery, crystal blue waters, exceptional cuisine, ancient architecture, and rich cultural traditions. With Discover Corps, you'll explore this multi-faceted country and experience all it has to offer with one of our expert guides.

We'll journey through Northern Thailand to the ancient cities of Chiang Mai and Sukhothai, exploring their ancient history and cultures, visiting beautiful temples and savoring tasty Thai cuisine at buzzing food markets. We'll also venture into the beautiful countryside of Northern Thailand, experiencing the scenic village of Mae Kampong and visiting an Elephant Sanctuary.

In these cities, we'll enjoy the festivities of Loy Krathong, known as Thailand's Festival of Lights. Dating back nearly 800 years, Loy Krathong is one of the biggest festivals in the country and takes place over multiple days. Your Discover Corps Guide will take you behind the scenes in both Sukhothai and Chiang Mai to learn about the festival, make your own krathong (a small boat/basket with candles and flowers), and participate in the festivities alongside locals.





DISCOVER THE LANTERN FESTIVAL

Loy Krathong, known as Thailand's Festival of Lights, dates back nearly 800 years and is one of the biggest festivals in the country. Taking place over one or two days, the people of Thailand celebrate by making krathongs, small lotus-shaped boats traditionally made from banana leaves and decorated with flowers that are then released along waterways as an offering of thanks to the Goddess of Water. The festival also includes firework shows, kathrong building competitions, beauty pageants, and more.

FESTIVAL HIGHLIGHTS



KRATHONGS (BOATS/BASKETS)

A krathong is a small lotus-shaped boat usually made from banana leaves, decorated with flowers, and filled with 3 sticks of incense and a lit candle. On the evening of the Loy Krathong festival, people gather around rivers, lakes, and canals to release these baskets in honor of the Goddess of Water.



TRADITIONAL THAI DANCING

Dance is an important part of Thai culture and plays a prominent role in Loy Krathong festivities. Celebrations throughout the festival can feature many dance forms, including traditional Lanna dances such as the fingernail dance (Fon Lep), candle dance, and circle dance. Dancers wear colorful, traditional Thai costumes and are joined by skilled musicians, often accompanying the dancers on traditional instruments.



LANTERNS

Thousands of floating lanterns are released into the sky, symbolizing the lantern bearer letting go of misfortunes from the previous and year and wishing good luck and fortune for the coming year. As part of the Discover Corps experience, you will have the opportunity to release lanterns into the sky while listening to the chanting of monks in a truly immersive experience.



FIREWORKS

Along with lanterns and krathongs, immaculate firework displays are one of the most visually stunning aspects of the Loy Krathong experience. Each regions festivities are slightly difference, but nightly firework displays remain constant across most celebrations. In Sukhothai, we'll attend a special evening performance of light shows, fireworks, and dance that encompasses the surrounding temples.



TRIP HIGHLIGHTS



ELEPHANT SANCTUARY

Elephants are one of the most iconic symbols of Thai wildlife and play an important role in their culture and folklore. However, the population is facing threats from poaching, habitat loss, and the unethical use of elephants in trade and tourism. During this unforgettable excursion to the Elephant Rescue Park you'll have the once-in-alifetime opportunity to feed and bathe the elephants with park volunteers, while learning more about the plight of the elephant and the role this renowned sanctuary plays in education and conservation.



LOY KRATHONG FESTIVAL

Loy Krathong, known as Thailand's Festival of Lights, dates back nearly 800 years and is one of the biggest festivals in the country, honoring the Goddess of Water and the Buddha. Taking place over one or two days, the people of Thailand celebrate by making krathongs (boats/baskets) at home with friends and family before heading to waterways or temples for religious rituals before releasing their krathongs. The festival also includes firework shows, kathrong building competitions, beauty competitions, and more.



MAE KAMPONG

Just 50 kilometers east of Chiang Mai is the village of Mae Kampong, a small town of <400 people, nestled in the mountains of Northern Thailand. One of the town's most famous attractions is the Flight of the Gibbon zipline, which offers visitors the chance to glide high in the rainforest canopy from one tree to another. The Discover Corps experience includes meeting with locals for a hike and tour of local plantations as well as a special opportunity for a home-cooked lunch with residents and a traditional Thai massage. Flight of the Gibbon is optional.



YI PENG FESTIVAL

The Yi Peng Lantern Festival also dates back nearly 800 years to the ancient Lanna Kingdom and was traditionally celebrated to mark the end of the monsoon season and beginning of the cool season. Many locals view the festival as a way to release negative energy and wish for good luck and fortune in the coming year, as well as honoring the Buddha. The most popular practice of the festival in the launch of thousands of lanterns into the night sky, but you can also expect to see rituals of worship, decoration contests, parades, traditional Thai dance shows, and live music.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive and relax before dinner at one of the top restaurants in Chiang Mai

Arrive in Chiang Mai and meet your Discover Corps guide and driver, who will assist with your hotel transfer. Get settled and relax before our welcome dinner at one of Chiang Mai's top restaurants. (D)

DAY 2: Experience the charm of Chiang Mai with visits to an herb garden, a local market, and an ancient temple

Today, we'll slow down and immerse ourselves in the laid-back pace of life and culture of Chiang Mai. We'll begin our morning with an intimate visit to a traditional herb garden before boarding a long tail boat for a scenic cruise on the Mae Ping River to the famous Warorot market. After taking our time to peruse the wares of local vendors, we'll climb aboard a pedal-powered rickshaw and travel the streets of Chiang Mai to the ancient Wat Phra Singh temple. Spend time enjoying the serenity of this tranquil, historic temple before returning to the hotel for a relaxing dinner together. (B,L,D)

DAY 3: Make your own amulet clay Buddha and learn traditional Thai cooking in the home of a local chef

After breakfast, we'll begin our drive to Sukhothai. After settling into our hotel and enjoying lunch, we'll head to a cultural center, Baan Phra Phim. Local expert, Mr. Kob, will guide us as we make a clay amulet Buddha, sharing with us the history and significance of such amulets while we create. He'll also provide a tour of the museum and live demonstrations of ancient activities. Enjoy a unique Discover Corps dinner experience in the home of talented local chef, Miss Na. She'll teach us how to make a few traditional Thai dishes, using local ingredients such as herbs and vegetables typical to Central Thailand's home gardens. You won't experience local, home-cooking quite like this anywhere else. (B,L,D)

DAY 4: Explore Sukhothai Historical Park by bike and participate in the city's Loy Krathong festivities

Enjoy a leisurely morning on your own or join the Suthep Sangkhalok making workshop. This hands-on experience allows you to paint your own ceramic bowl at the iconic Suthep Sangklalok factory while learning about this historic bowl and how its produced. This afternoon, we'll hop aboard bikes to explore Sukhothai Historical Park (tuk tuk ride also available for those that do not bike). In the evening, we'll enjoy the Loy Krathong celebration where you can expect to see displays of lighted candles and fireworks, folk dancing, and a spectacular light and sound presentation. (B,D)















DAY 5: Explore the ancient Sri Satchanalai temples and enjoy Krathong celebrations and activities in Chiang Mai

After an early breakfast at the hotel, we'll drive to the site of an ancient town at the Sri Satchanalai Historical Park. Visit numerous monuments throughout the park including stunning ancient temples and the Thuriang Kilns, an archeological site containing the ruins of a 13th century pottery factory that features the oldest known kilns in Thailand. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before making the drive back to Chiang Mai. Once we've arrived, you can either rest or take an evening walk around the town to enjoy the Krathong celebration, decorations, activities, and more. (B,L,D)

DAY 6: Bathe and feed elephants at the Elephant Rescue Park and enjoy an immersive experience at the Yi Peng Festival event

Prepare yourself for an unforgettable excursion to the Elephant Rescue Park in the picturesque valley of Chiang Mai, a sanctuary and rescue center for Asian elephants. Experience a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to feed and bathe the elephants with park volunteers. Later that night, we'll join the annual Yi Peng Event for an unforgettable evening of traditional dance performances as thousands of candle-lit offerings are sent out on the river. (B,L,D)

DAY 7: Experience Mae Kampong's scenery and relax with a traditional Thai massage

Sleep in for a bit before we head for the rolling hills of North Thailand, specifically the beautiful rural village of Mae Kampong. We'll make a stop along the way at a local market where we'll purchase fresh ingredients for our lunch. In Mae Kampong, your Discover Corps Guide will introduce you to locals who will take us on a light hike to explore and learn about their coffee and tea plantations before we enjoy a home-cooked meal. Relax after lunch with a Thai massage, allowing the tranquil setting and traditional techniques refresh your body and mind. You'll also have the option to tour the village further or put your thrill to the test with the "Flight of the Gibbon" adventure ziplining across the rainforest canopy. We'll end the evening back in Chiang Mai with an elegant farewell dinner. (B,L,D)

DAY 8: Return Home

After breakfast at the hotel, your guide will transfer you to the airport to catch your flight home. (B)
