### THE PYRAMIDS OF GIZA

Dating back to 2550 B.C. the Pyramids of Giza are the only remaining standing monument of the Wonders of the Ancient World. Constructed as tombs for three of Egypt's pharaohs, the Pyramids of Giza continue to puzzle archaeologists and engineers alike. An estimated 10,000-20,000 workers spent over 20 years constructing the pyramids using extremely heavily stones from miles away. You'll have to pinch yourself as you stare in awe at these iconic landmarks set against the vast Egyptian desert landscape.




### SAILING THE NILE RIVER

## ITINERARY

### **DAY 1:** Arrive in Cairo

Our Egyptian adventure begins in the ancient city of Cairo. Arrive into Cairo International Airport (CAI) and meet your Discover Corps Guide for the journey ahead. We'll get a brief introduction to the area before settling into the historic Nile Ritz Carlton Hotel on the banks of the Nile River. We'll enjoy a delicious Welcome Dinner together with our guide and celebrate our arrival in one of the world's most interesting places. (D)

# **DAY 2:** See the Pyramids and Learn about Modern Egypt

Today's adventure begins with a morning visit to one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, the Pyramids of Giza. An Egyptologist guide, who serves as an expert in the Pyramids, will join us and walk us through the history and mysteries of these ancient tombs.

Later in the afternoon, we'll experience a warm Egyptian welcome at a local family's house in Cairo. This is an extremely unique opportunity to learn about life in Egypt today, try some of the country's best dishes and get a glimpse into day-to-day life in one of the world's oldest cities. (B,L,D)

# **DAY 3:** Fly to Southern Egypt and visit a Traditional Nubian Village

After breakfast, we'll head to the airport for a short flight to the southern city of Aswan. A quiet town the banks of the Nile, Aswan is filled with antiquities and will be the starting point for our Nile Cruise. After settling into our 5-star lodging on Elephantine Island, we'll venture to one of the colorful Nubian Villages that dot the desert landscape. Nubia is the region along the Nile between Egypt and Sudan and is home to one of the oldest civilizations in Africa. To visit a Nubian Village is to take a step back in time. Experience the colorful buildings of Nubian society and learn about their culture, language, music and art. Most importantly, you'll have the chance to experience the Nubian's famous generosity, cheerfulness and modesty. Later in the day, we'll return to Aswan for a relaxing dinner together. # **DAY 4:** Set Sail on the Nile River & Explore the Temples of Aswan

Wake up to a colorful sunrise over the desert and breakfast overlooking the Nile River. Today, we'll board our home for the next 3 nights, the 5-star Alexander the Great Nile cruise. Unlike most ships making the 135-mile journey between Aswan and Luxor, ours is one of the smallest, a floating boutique hotel boasting just 30 rooms, a pool, a sundeck and plenty of space to roam.

The Nile River is a place of love and respect for the Egyptian people. And to sail the calm waters is an experience unlike any other. From the ship, you'll see day-to-day life taking place on the banks of the river while stopping along the way to see temples, obelisks and tombs scattered along the shores. Our guide will join us for the journey serving as a personal concierge throughout the experience. We'll also be treated to a fantastic array of food, entertainment and sights along the journey. ## **DAY 5**: Continue our Journey along the Nile River

Set sail to the historic Kom Ombo Temple. Standing tall at a bend in the Nile, this temple is unique in that it is dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek. We'll explore the temple and it's intricate hieroglyphics before continuing on our journey to the ancient settlement of Edfu on the Western Bank of the Nile. Renowned for its impressive temple dedicated to Horus, the falcon god, we'll enjoy a narrated journey with our guide. Hop back on board the ship for afternoon tea and a colorful Egyptian folkloric show. Sail into the sunset and take in the natural beauty of this corner of Egypt. (B,L,D)

# **DAYS 6 & 7:** Sail to Luxor and Disembark in the World's Largest Open-Air Museum

We'll continue on our final day of sailing on the Nile River. After breakfast, we'll venture out to explore the historic West Bank of Luxor. This is where the Egyptians buried their dead and remains to this day one of the largest collections of archaeological treasures in the world. From Tutankhamun to Ramses, the most powerful nobles and their families from Egyptian history are buried here. We'll join our Egyptologist guide to interpret the colorful hieroglyphics and hear the stories of grandeur and beauty that this site represents. (B,L,D)

Continue to the East Bank of Luxor to explore the Karnak and Luxor Temples. An extraordinary complex of sanctuaries, obelisks and temples, Karanak was an extremely important place of worship. The Temple of Amun-Ra dominates the complex and contains some of the most well preserved structures in Egypt.









The following day, we'll fly back to Cairo. We'll make a special visit to one of our local non-profit partners to see firsthand how they are working to help the youth in Cairo obtain education and opportunities. Settle in to our quaint boutique hotel in Cairo's leafy suburbs for a relaxing evening together. (B,L,D)

# **DAY 8**: Explore Cairo's Mosques & Markets. Savor a memorable Farewell Dinner together.

Today, we'll spend our final day exploring of Cairo's ancient markets, mosques and museums. Head to the Cairo's Citadel, a collection of Mosques, palaces and amazing views of the city. Built at the height of Islamic rule in the 1100's, take in the incredible intricacies of the Muhammad Ali Mosque while learning about this fascinating era of history in Egypt. We'll then head to the Khan el Khalili market to shop for souvenirs and explore one of the oldest markets in Africa and the Middle East. End the afternoon taking in the iconic Egyptian Museum to see some of the best preserved artifacts from Egyptian civilization.

In the evening, we'll have a delicious Farewell Dinner together in Cairo recounting our memories of the trip and savoring the delicious Egyptian cuisine. (B,L,D)
