Meet the locals behind the flavors, sip Greek wines, and sample awardwinning olive oils, ending your journey with the perfect souvlaki under the Athenian sky.



SUNSET CRUISE & SANTORINI'S BEACHES

Explore Santorini's volcanic beauty in style—traveling by private minivan through medieval villages and winding coastal roads. Snap the perfect photo of the famed blue domes, visit a centuries-old winery, and watch the sun dip into the sea in one of the most breathtaking sunset spots on Earth.



FARM TO TABLE THE CRETAN WAY

In the hills of Zaros, leave the city behind and reconnect with the land. At Kamihis Farm, you'll become part of a multi-generational tradition—milking sheep, baking on open fires, and learning about medicinal herbs and mountain produce. End the experience with homemade raki and a true farm feast, serenaded by the sounds of nature and village life.



POTTERY IN THE MOUNTAINS

Step into the soul of Cretan artistry in Margarites village. Here, local potters keep alive ancient ceramic techniques passed down for generations. You'll try your hand at the wheel, gaining insight into the connection between craftsmanship, tradition, and daily life. It's a moment of creation—and connection—you'll never forget.



ITINERARY

SIGNATURE JOURNEY

DAY 1: Welcome to Greece!

Upon arrival in the historic capital of Athens, you'll be met at the airport by our team and transferred to your boutique hotel in Athens' historic city center. After settling-in, meet your guide and fellow travelers for an overview of the week ahead, followed by a welcome dinner just a short walk from the hotel. The menu highlights traditional Greek flavors and introduces you to the warm hospitality that Greece is known for. (D)

DAY 2: Ancient Athens & Culinary Exploration

After breakfast, embark on a guided tour through thousands of years of history. Marvel at the grandeur of the Acropolis, home to the Parthenon, Temple of Athena Nike and the Erechtheion. Continue with a visit to the Acropolis Museum, where you'll gain deeper insight into the mythology, artistry, and everyday life of ancient Athens.

In the afternoon, shift gears as you delve into modern Greek culture through its cuisine. Join a 4-hour walking food tour through Athens' vibrant neighborhoods—sampling *koulóuria, loukoumades,* cheeses and local wines. Visit bustling markets, family-run shops and charming tavernas that reveal the heart of the city. (*B,D*)

DAY 3: Morning of Purpose & Free Time

Today is dedicated to meaningful engagement with Humanity Greece, a grassroots organization working to combat poverty and food insecurity in the city. You'll meet the team and learn how they are creating a model of community-based relief that supports families across Athens. Through conversations, hands-on involvement and storytelling, gain perspective on the challenges and triumphs of navigating a complex, changing society.

Enjoy a delicious lunch in the city center, followed by a free afternoon to explore Athens at your own pace. Wander through Plaka's winding lanes, visit a nearby museum or relax at a café with views of the Acropolis. (*B,L*)

DAY 4: Santorini Magic & Sunset Views

After breakfast, transfer to the Athens Airport for a short flight to the island of Santorini. Upon arrival, take some time to soak in the breathtaking scenery—whitewashed buildings, vivid blue domes, and dramatic cliffs rising from the sea.

Enjoy a traditional lunch featuring local island flavors before joining an afternoon guided tour that brings Santorini's beauty to life. Uncover panoramic viewpoints, medieval villages like Megalochori and Pyrgos, and a local winery where you'll sample the island's volcanic wines during a wine tasting session. End the day at one of Santorini's iconic sunset spots, watching the sun dip below the horizon in a golden display. (*B,L*)























DAY 5: Sailing the Caldera

Spend the morning at leisure—perhaps wandering through Fira's cobblestone streets, shopping for artisanal souvenirs, or relaxing on the black sand beaches of Kamari or Perissa.

In the early afternoon, board a semi-private luxury catamaran for a cruise around Santorini's famed caldera, the gem of the Aegean Sea. Sail past white cliffs, swim in warm, crystal-clear waters, and explore hidden coves. As you cruise, enjoy a freshly prepared dinner onboard featuring seafood, salads, and traditional Greek dishes. Watch the sun set from the water, wine in hand, with views that will stay with you long after you leave. (B,D)

DAY 6: Black Sand Beaches & Crete's Local Charm

Enjoy a final leisurely morning in Santorini with time for a swim or stroll by the sea. Then enjoy lunch at the iconic Barolo Beach Bar, a relaxed local restaurant on the black sands of Perivolos, a quaint beach town on the Southeastern corner of Santorini, where fresh seafood meets Aegean vibes.

In the afternoon, board a ferry for a two-hour sail to Heraklion, the capital of Crete. Upon arrival, join your guide for a casual walking tour of the city's historic streets, where Venetian architecture meets modern island life. Learn about the island's unique culture and history as you explore the quaint alleyways. Dinner tonight is on your own—choose from Heraklion's many lively tavernas that line the streets and come alive with nightfall. (B,L)

DAY 7: Day on a Farm in Crete

After breakfast, travel to the tranquil village of Zaros in the Cretan countryside for a day immersed in rural tradition. At Kamihis Farm, you'll experience the rhythms of Cretan life—gathering herbs, feeding animals, tasting fruit from the trees, and even learning how to make traditional cheese and savory pies over an open flame. Ride a donkey named Louiza through olive groves, sip homemade raki, and share a rustic meal of ingredients harvested just hours before. This will be a unique glimpse into traditional farm life in Crete.

After lunch, take a peaceful walk around nearby Lake Zaros, where you'll enjoy coffee and conversation under the trees. Return to Heraklion with a new appreciation for the wisdom of slow living and free time to explore on your own. (B,L)

DAY 8: Rethymno Village & Mountain Pottery

Today, venture along the northern coast to the historic town of Rethymno, a beautifully preserved mix of Venetian and Ottoman architecture. Begin with a traditional Cretan breakfast at a hidden "kafenio" in a quiet square, complete with handmade pies and jam. Stroll through cobbled streets and learn how Rethymno's culinary and architectural history are deeply intertwined.

After lunch in an elegant garden restaurant, continue to the mountain village of Margarites. Here, join a hands-on pottery workshop with local artisans who preserve ancient techniques of ceramic craftsmanship. Create your own piece and hear the stories behind each design. Cap off the day with a festive Farewell Dinner at a village taverna before returning to Heraklion. (B,L,D)



Enjoy a relaxed morning as you bid farewell to your fellow travelers and prepare for your journey home. Individual transfers will be arranged based on your flight schedule. You'll leave Greece not only with stunning photos, but with new stories and connections. (B,L,D)
